Deep-blue fjords, breathtaking mountains, and flowing waterfalls... these are natural wonders you'll experience in Norway... all of this and more.

A highlight of this Norway tour is a breathtaking ride on the Flåm railway, one of the world's most scenic train rides, which passes through 20 tunnels and climbs to an elevation of 2,833 feet. View waterfalls cascading down the side of steep, snowcapped mountains, rivers winding through deep gorges; farms on the side of steep slopes, and views of Sognefjord.

Travel on the Hardanger National Tourist Road taking you through some of Norway's most stunning scenery, stop at Steinsdalsfossen waterfall, and walk behind the cascading falls without getting wet! In Borgund, you'll visit the best preserved Stave Church dating back to 1810. Stay two nights in beautiful

Bergen and last, but not least, enjoy a relaxing and scenic train ride back to Oslo with an additional hotel night.





<u>DAY 1, MONDAY, AUGUST 31:</u> <u>Welcome to Norway!</u> This evening, meet your Tour Director and travel companions for a <u>welcome dinner</u>.

<u>DAY 2, TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 1:</u> Oslo. City guided sightseeing includes a walk through Frogner Park and a visit to city hall. <u>TOUR HIGHLIGHT:</u> Frogner Park includes over 200 sculptures created by the legendary sculptor, Gustav Vigeland. Visit the beautiful Oslo City Hall with soaring towers and 49 bells. The Nobel Peace Prize Ceremony takes place here each year. **Breakfast.**

<u>DAY 3, WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 2:</u> <u>Borgund.</u> The stave churches are Norway's most important contribution toward architecture and Norway's oldest preserved timber building. One of the most famous and distinctive is Borgund's, built around 1180 and dedicated to the Apostle Andrew. <u>Breakfast & Dinner.</u>

<u>DAY 4, THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 3:</u> Flam-Myrdal-Voss-Hardangerfjord. Today, ride the spectacular Flam train. Get on board and journey past deep ravines, cascading waterfalls, snow capped peaks and more on one of the world's steepest standard-gauge railway lines. **Breakfast & Dinner.**

<u>DAY 5, FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 4:</u> Hardangerfjord-Steinsdalsfossen-Bergen. Visit the favorite retreat of Emperor Kaiser Wilhelm II of Germany at Steinsdalsfossen. It's believed that the Emperor frequently visited this beautifu setting and its falls each summer between 1889 and the start of WWI in 1914. Breakfast.


<u>DAY 6, SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 5:</u> Bergen. Enjoy an orientation drive including Bryggen, the Hanseatic Wharf, the harbor and the Fish Market. Beautiful Bergen paints a shoreline with different hues of its wooden houses and shops along the old wharf on Norway's southwestern shore. Often called the "Fjord Capitol of Norway," Bergen will charm you with its quaint charisma and its amazing setting between the seven mountains. A great place to shop for your favorite Norwegian souvenirs!

<u>DAY 7, SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 6:</u> Bergen-Oslo. Sit back and relax on an amazing train ride back to Oslo. Cross the Hardangervidda National Park and onto the Hardangervidda plateau, Europe's largest high-mountain plateau. Breakfast.

<u>DAY 8, MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 7:</u> Oslo. Transfer to airport and travel home today or extend your vacation as desired. <u>Breakfast</u>.
