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
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VACATION OVERVIEW

Day 1 ARRIVE IN SHANNON, IRELAND–LIMERICK

Day 3 LIMERICK–ADARE–RING OF KERRY–KILLARNEY

ADARE Stop at the quaint village to see its pretty thatched cottages.

RING OF KERRY Panoramic drive around the island's southwestern tip.

KILLARNEY Free time.

Day 4 KILLARNEY–BLARNEY–CAHIR–DUBLIN

BLARNEY Visit the village renowned for its magical Kissing Stone with free time to explore.

CAHIR Photo stop.

DUBLIN Free time this afternoon.

Day 5 DUBLIN

DUBLIN Morning orientation drive to see O'Connell Street, Georgian squares, St. Patrick's Cathedral, and Trinity College. Free time this afternoon.

Day 6 DUBLIN–GIANT'S CAUSEWAY, NORTHERN IRELAND–BELFAST

GIANT'S CAUSEWAY See more than 40,000 interlocking basalt columns formed millions years ago.

BELFAST Visit Titanic Experience museum.

Day 7 BELFAST-EDINBURGH, SCOTLAND

Ferry crossing on the North Channel to Cairnryan on Scotland's southwest coast.

Scenic drive through Scottish border country to Edinburgh.

Day 8 EDINBURGH

EDINBURGH Morning city sightseeing with a Local Guide includes the New Town, Old Town, and a visit to Edinburgh Castle to see Scotland's Crown Jewels. Free time this afternoon.

Day 9 EDINBURGH-ALNWICK, ENGLAND-YORK

ALNWICK At Alnwick Castle choose to visit the Castle or explore the garden.

YORK See York Minster on a guided walk through The Shambles.

Day 10 YORK-STRATFORD-UPON-AVON-BATH

STRATFORD-UPON-AVON See Anne Hathaway's Cottage and visit Shakespeare's Birthplace.

BATH Visit the excavations of the Roman Baths.

Day 11 BATH-STONEHENGE-LONDON

STONEHENGE Guided visit.

Day 12 LONDON

LONDON Morning sightseeing with a Local Guide includes the Houses of Parliament, Big Ben, Westminster Abbey, Whitehall, Prime Minister's Downing Street residence, Piccadilly Circus, and Buckingham Palace. Free time this afternoon.
